



Welcome to Ulusaba Private Game Reserve

WHERE IS ULUSABA?

Ulusaba Private Game Reserve is located in the western sector of the Sabi Sand Reserve near Kruger National Park in the Mpumalanga province of South Africa. It's approximately one hour 20 minutes by twin-engine aircraft to the Ulusaba airstrip from Johannesburg International Airport (also known as O.R. Tambo Airport) and 30 minutes from Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport (KMIA) in Nelspruit. Fly Virgin Atlantic Airways via London to Johannesburg or direct from the US East Coast with other carriers.

HOW MANY ROOMS ARE THERE?

Ulusaba has two beautiful lodges. **Rock Lodge** is on the summit of a koppie set against the backdrop of the Drakensberg Mountain range far in the distance. Rock Lodge includes Ulusaba's newest addition Cliff Lodge and can accommodate a total of 20 – 25 guests in its 10 rooms.

Safari Lodge is built along the banks of the dry Mabrak riverbed. Guests will love the sense of adventure as they cross the 'Raiders of the Lost Ark' style swing bridges between exquisite tree house rooms, created and inspired by local and natural materials, with elephants, bushbucks, lions and other local wildlife passing by. Safari Lodge can accommodate 22 guests in its 11 rooms.

WHAT ARE THE RATES?

Rates are quoted in South African Rand and range from ZAR 5,000 to ZAR 15,400 per person per night until 18th December 2013. Choose from a selection of rooms and suites: some rooms are perfect for children, including one which can be a triple, and some rooms have balconies and plunge pools. The rates include accommodation, all food and beverages including fine champagne, twice daily game drives, game walks, taxes and friendly staff! Rates are subject to change at any time. Minimum stays may apply.

Cubs under 12 years old are welcome at Rock Lodge and Cubs over 6 years old can take advantage of the twice-daily game drives. Cubs under 6 are not able to go on game drives but our staff will be sure to keep them entertained.
